- **Registration:**
Opens: July 1, 2019
Closes: September 31, 2019 5:00pm JST
- **Open to:** ANY KID, from ANY WHERE that is from 8-18 years and on a team of 2 to 4 players

Team Divisions:

- **Teams:** A team is any group of 2, 3 OR 4 players. The oldest person determines the team division. Three team divisions (oldest team member determines division level):

(ES): Elementary School (grades 3-5)

(MS): Middle School (grades 6-8)

(HS): High School (grades 9-12)

Coaches & Assistant Coaches:

- Coaches start by Registration page; you enter some information of you.
- Enter your team info including what division and challenges
- **Cost / person:** At the place of this event, the coaches pay the participation fee which is **2,000 yen** / 1(one) kid (**included two lunches**). **You need to pay 500 yen per kid for an additional challenge.**

<EX.>

If your team have 4 kids and it will take part in a-MAZE-ing Challenge and Jousting Challenge. Your team pays 10000 yen. (2000 yen×4 kids+500 yen×4 kids)

About the 2019 Robot Challenges:

a-MAZE-ing Challenge: separate ES, MS divisions

Jousting Challenge: separate ES, MS divisions

Line Following Challenge: separate ES, MS, HS divisions

SumoBot Challenge: separate ES, MS, HS divisions

Fire Fighting Challenge: MS, HS, but NO divisions

Robotovate: MS, HS, but NO divisions

- Prizes awarded for each challenge; each division
- Any robot platform is allowed provided the total value is equal to or less than \$1500 USD
- Any programming language can be used
- NO Bluetooth / NO remote control (except for Robotovate)

About Scoring:

- Teams earn points by running their robots when a track is available (no heats – just find a track and run!)
- The any of top teams per challenge advance to tournaments (see the rule of each challenge)
- Tournaments – single elimination based on performance only
